

Registration

After a successful Placement, the conditions of participation will be sent via e-mail. These must be printed out, signed and sent back via post to Workcamp Switzerland.

The best way to register for several workcamps if wished is to note down the workcamps you wish to attend on the registration Form found on the workcamp Switzerland website under the field marked "remarks"

Please note that the order of the selected projects acts as a priority list. Especially in the peak season, projects are quickly booked.

The number of vacancies displayed in the search engine acts only as an indication and not as a guarantee. Many organizations prefer internationally composed groups, and accept no more than two or three participants from the same country.

If it is not possible to place the participant in one of the selected projects, his or her registration will be deleted and the placement fee will be refunded or workcamp Switzerland will look for other suitable alternatives after consultation with the participant.

Fees

The registration fee is:

Workcamp in Switzerland:	CHF 150
Workcamp abroad:	CHF 250
Long term project (from 1 month):	CHF 350

In case of cancellation and rebooking to another project, the following additional fees are applicable:

Workcamp in Switzerland:	CHF 50
Workcamp abroad:	CHF 100
Long term project (from 1 months):	CHF 100

The period of payment is 14 days.

When making payments please use the Workcamp code as reference.

Additional costs

In general, the rule amongst Project-organizations is that there should be no additional costs for the participants. Not all organizations can comply with this principle. Especially in poor countries, additional participation fees are demanded for participation in a project. Any additional participation fees are noted in the project description.

Cancellation / Cancellation cost

If the participant is unable to participate in a workcamp, he or she should promptly notify Workcamp Switzerland.

If the registration is cancelled by the participant, the following cancellation costs apply as a percentage of the registration fee:

Up to 0 days before the start of the Project:	100%
No show:	100%
Illness or injury (including medical note from the doctor)	0%

If the project is cancelled by the partner organization, the following cancellation costs apply as a percentage of the registration fee:

Up to 0 days before the start of the project:	0%
Cancellation on site:	0%

For additional costs (pocket money, ...) that arise in connection with the proposed project Workcamp Switzerland assumes no liability.

If desired, instead of a cancellation a transfer can be made to another project. There is no guarantee for an equivalent project.

Cancellations must be made in writing.

Arrival and departure

The participant is responsible for planning and booking his or her trip. The costs are covered by the participant.

Commitments

The participant is expected to inform him or herself about the current visa requirements, the current situation of the target country and take the necessary measures (vaccinations, visas, etc.).

General Information

The minimum age is 18 years (except for teenage projects)

The workcamp language is usually English. Exceptions are noted in the project description.

The participant works for approximately 6 hours per day. Exceptions are noted in the project description.

A free membership for Workcamp Switzerland for the current year is automatically offered to those who participate in a project.

The participant receives one month before the project begins detailed information on the project in the form of an information sheet.

Projects may experience short-term changes (ex. caused by weather, everyday situation, ...).

Liability of Workcamp Switzerland

Workcamp Switzerland disclaims any liability for damages suffered by the participants, especially in case of accidents, sickness and theft.

The insurance protection is the participant's responsibility.

Jurisdiction

The ordinary courts under the zip code 8000 Zurich build up the Jurisdiction.
Swiss law is applicable.
